

and then we catch the mid-afternoon ferry to Plymouth. This reaches England around 2030 and the coach will then return you to the original pick up points.

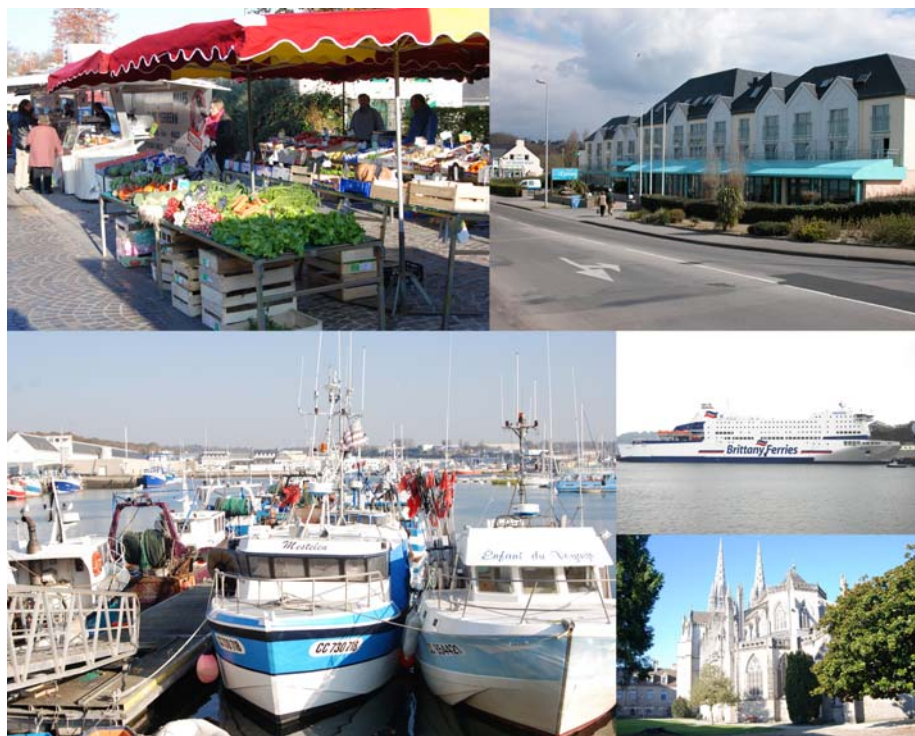

## The 2009 Programme

Regular supporters of the Dart Valley Stompers will be pleased to know that the Band is going on tour again in 2009.

We've opted to return to Concarneau ,where we enjoyed a successful visit in 2008, for many reasons - nice hotel, wonderful setting, good food, interesting excursions and a good environment for the jazz sessions. Very little travelling is involved and for those who went last year - no fish at the hotel!!

The Band plays after dinner each evening at the hotel . We hope they will also play on the ferry but at the time of writing Brittany Ferries are not certain that their brand new ship, the "Armorique", will have facilities for live groups.

## JAZZ IN BRITTANY 5 days

We set off on Monday and drive to Plymouth for the 2200 sailing to France. A cabin is provided .

On Tuesday morning after landing around 0700 we will drive to the centre of the nearest town, Morlaix, which will just be opening up for the day. You'll have a chance to have a coffee or local breakfast then do some sightseeing in this interesting old town.

We then resume our drive over the Armorique National Park with a short stop in Pleyben and thence to Concarneau where we check in to the 3\* Hotel l'Ocean situated on the Baie de la Foret. The hotel rooms are comfortable and naturally have private facilities en-suite. In the grounds of the hotel is a covered swimming pool for your added pleasure.

The rest of this afternoon is free for you to explore Concarneau. After dinner this evening, the Band plays in the bar for your enjoyment.

On Wednesday we are travelling south to the pleasant town of Vannes. It cathedral situated in the pedestrianised Old Quarter and there are many other interesting buildings as well as a lively harbour area . We return to the hotel for dinner and more entertainment from the Band. On Thursday we set off for Quimper, the main town of this area, where we will spend the morning. In the early afternoon we will stop at the Distillerie du Plessis, a unique museum of Breton drinks. From here we proceed to the nearby Kinkiz Cider Establishment for a tasting of their product. We then return to the hotel for dinner and entertainment.

We leave the hotel on Friday morning and travel to the outskirts of Morlaix for a visit to the Hypermarket. Our final port of call will be the Red Cash Wine and Beer Warehouse
