Colin is a very accomplished bass player and although he keeps quiet about his past bass playing we do know that he has played with Kenny Ball Jazz Band. Colin has been depping for Lukas whilst he has been unavailable over the past 6 months or so and has fitted in a treat.

Of himself Colin says:- Colin comes from the Reading area, played around London for many years before moving to Devon. He has a long association with Graham Hewitt's Society Jazzband which is a well-known and respected band around the Home Counties. Colin has been with The Stannary Jazzmen for the past 12 years but his services are in much demand by many and the appreciation of his fine playing includes an association with nationally renowned guitarist Tony Oreshko.

Jeremy says:-

From time to time most bands go through personnel changes. We have been in lucky in DVS in that the front line has remained consistent since the band's inception. The rhythm section has changed but each time it's changed, it has changed for the better as I've tried to find players that 'are the best fit'.

I believe that the recent changes have now bedded in and that the band is back to having a steady line up which will continue to play the lively Traditional & New Orleans Jazz that has made the Dart Valley Stompers so popular with audiences all over the country.
